Description of Booster Club Activities and Events that need your help:

Spirit Wear: Assist with sales of Rockford Lutheran spirit wear at games and other events

Father/Daughter Event: Help organize/run a fun father/daughter event for the high school

Teacher Appreciation: BC sponsors teacher appreciation each month with treats, lunch or a gift

Anywhere I am Needed: You are willing to help out for any of our events.

Check Awards Fundraiser: This is our fall fundraiser where the whole school sells books with cash certificates to over 25 businesses throughout Rockford. This is one of our major fundraisers that needs people for a day or two to prepare packets and fill envelopes with orders.

On the Waterfront Fundraiser: A fun event for couples where we manage a beverage booth.

Grade Specific Rec Night: Help organize/run a grade specific rec night that the BC helps fund.

Booster Club Membership: At the beginning of school the BC launches in membership campaign

Garage Sale: In early May the BC runs a garage sale at the school as a fundraiser.

Mother/Son Event: Help organize/run a fun mother/son event for the high school

Tuition Raffle Volunteer: In early spring the BC runs a tuition raffle that involves mailing out forms and tracking returned entries.

Clean-up Day: On a Saturday in August the BC sponsors a clean-up day at the school.

Evergreen Ball Fundraiser: At this winter event the BC helps with coat check and valet parking. Students and parents typically work this event.

Concession Volunteer: During the year people are needed for a few hours in the concession stand.

Golf Play Day: In May/June volunteers are needed to help plan and execute this very fun event.

Bake Treats for Staff: Once a month treats are provided for the teachers and staff.

Dip-ette Volunteer: Serve ice cream sundaes to students first Thursday of month with proceeds going to Renaissance.

Renaissance: This is a program which rewards students for the academic achievement.

Stress Free Finals: In December a healthy snack is provided for the Jr and Sr high students during exam week.
