DRESS CODE

2025-2026 School Year





BOTTOMS

- Flat front or pleated-front styles must be worn
- Pants or shorts must fit loosely and not contain rips or holes
- Jeans, Athletic, Sweatpants, Cargo and Spandex pants/shorts are not allowed
- Pants and shorts must be a solid navy, black or khaki color

SKIRTS AND JUMPERS

- Solid navy, black, khaki, or Clear Blue Plaid (from Lands' End) are allowed
- Skirts must extend to mid-thigh. Skirts may not be unzipped, unbuttoned, or rolled up. Plain, solid-color tights or leggings may be worn under a skirt or jumper











UNIFORM TOPS

SHIRTS

- · Solid polo or oxford style shirts in any color
- Short or long sleeve style
- 1" Logo allowed

SWEATERS & SWEATSHIRTS

- Solid zip-up or hooded style sweatshirts can be worn over a polo or oxford shirt
- Pullover or cardigan sweaters in solid colors
- 1" Logo allowed
- · Hoods may not be worn in school









SHOES

- · Closed toe and covered heel footwear must be worn at all times
- · Slides, slippers (including UGG Tasman), sandals (including Crocs), and flip flops are not permitted



PRESCHOOL - 5TH GRADE



Rockford Lutheran wishes to establish a climate in which learning can thrive without distractions by extremes in dress. The principles of modesty, simplicity, good taste and neatness are core values that relate to Christian dress. The following "standardized dress" code is in effect at the elementary campus for all students. All clothing must be of the approved color and style.

PURPOSE

- ·Exemplify Christian modesty
- Display professionalism and pride in our identity as RLS
- ·Focus attention on classroom instruction
- ·Minimize socio-economic distinctions

CONSEQUENCES FOR NOT ADHERING TO THE DRESS CODE

- 1. Warning and sent to the office to change into appropriate attire if needed. A copy of the Dress Code will be sent home. Recorded in discipline file as 1st Warning.
- 2. Sent to the office to change into appropriate attire. The student will have a conference with the Principal, and parents will be called. Recorded in discipline file as 2nd Warning.
- 3. Sent to the office to change into appropriate attire. The student will have a conference with the Principal, a detention will be issued, and parents will be called. Recorded in discipline file as 3rd Warning.
- 4. Beyond # 3- Parents are called to pick up student and take home to get into Dress Code, and any afterschool activities suspended for 1 week (isolated lunch if no activities).

UNIFORM TOPS

- Any solid color polo or oxford shirt.
- A 1" logo may be worn on a solid color polo or oxford shirt.
- A solid color long-sleeve or short-sleeve shirt may be worn under the polo or oxford shirt. This shirt may contain a 1" logo.
- Ties may be worn with an oxford shirt and may be solid-colored or patterned, but should not contain any characters or writing.
- Tops must fit appropriately so that the stomach area or upper torso are never exposed.

SWEATERS & SWEATSHIRTS

- A solid color sweatshirt or sweater may be worn over the polo or oxford shirt. This garment may contain a 1" logo.
- A spirit wear sweatshirt may be worn over the polo or oxford shirt.
- On Fridays spirit wear tops may be worn in place of the polo or oxford shirt.
- · Hoods may not be worn in school.

SHORTS, SKIRTS, JUMPERS & DRESSES

- Shorts, skirts, and jumpers must extend to mid-thigh. Skirts may not be unzipped, unbuttoned, or rolled-up.
- No undergarments are to be visible above the pants or skirt waistline or below the pants or skirt hem.
- Shorts may be tan (khaki), navy, or black. Skirts and jumpers may be these colors or Clear Blue Plaid (Lands' End®) or RR Plaid.
- Shorts or skirts may have inside pockets, but no pockets stitched on the outside
- Polo dresses of any solid color may be worn, but must fit the length requirement. A 1" logo may be present on the polo dress.
- Tights/leggings may be worn under shorts or skirts. These can have colors or patterns, but should be free of holes.

PANTS

- Pants may be tan (khaki), navy, or black. No denim.
- Pants shall have no pockets stitched on the outside.
- Pants must fit loosely and cannot have any holes or frays.
- Jeans, athletic pants, sweatpants, cargo, and spandex pants/shorts are not allowed.

SHOES

- Closed-toe shoes that are secured behind the heel must be worn at all times. Slides, slippers (including UGG Tasman), sandals (including Crocs), and flip flops are not permitted.
- Athletic shoes are required for Physical Education class. These can be kept at school.

HEAD

- Hair should be kept neat and away from the eyes.
- No bleaching or unnatural coloring of hair is allowed.
- Hats, caps, any headwear, sweatbands, or sunglasses (unless specified by a doctor) cannot be worn during school hours. Exceptions will be made for spirit days.

OTHER

- Makeup is not to be worn.
- Press-on nails are not allowed as they are a distraction to the learning environment.
- Jewelry should be modest and safe. Spiked, excessively long, or heavy chains are not permitted. No dangling earrings.
- · Students will be asked to remove any jewelry or items that are a distraction to the class.
- No tattoos or body piercings other than the ear are allowed.
- No clothing shall have writing on it.
- Standardized dress may be purchased anywhere as long as it meets the above standards. They can also be ordered through Lands' End.


CHROMEBOOK REQUIREMENT

We would like to use this time to remind parents that all students entering grades 6 through 12 will be required to have a SCHOOL USE ONLY Chromebook laptop device of their own to use at school on a daily basis. Please refer to the Resources tab on RockfordLutheran.org for more information on our One-to-One Chromebook Program and why it is a crucial part of our student's education.

The recommended Chromebook units are clearly marked with a symbol to identify them. Our suggestions for specifications are: RAM: 2+ gig (4 gig recommended)

Storage: 16+ GB
Graphics: HD
Case: durable

- Once the unit has been purchased it will need to be placed into Rockford Lutheran's Google Apps for the Education Domain.
- Each device has a \$40.00 domain fee that will be charged via FACTS. Domains are no longer transferrable between devices. A new Domain must be purchased for \$40.00/unit if you replace your current Chromebook.
- All Chromebooks that are added to the Rockford Lutheran domain MUST be added from a factory setting. This will involve a reset of your current Chromebook which in turn will require it to be for school use only.

WHAT IS FACTS?

• FACTS is our school information system (SIS). It houses all family contact information, student medical information, student attendance and behavior reports, grades (synced from Canvas in the 6-12 campus), report cards, transcripts, and other relevant documents. Both parents/guardians and students have access to their own separate accounts, which offer different access points to areas specific to the individual. Example: Parents or guardians have access to the enrollment dashboard and can update their contact information; students do not have this access.






